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Component (Group) Selection

Lock 3 Components: Schedules vary, **1st session June 12– July 14**(skipping week of July 3-7) and **2nd session July 17-August 11**

Each applicant chosen will only be selected for one component and one session

Each component is **60 hours for 4 weeks**

You may interview for up to two components, choices can be changed at interview, tentatively choose below:

- Neighborhood Posts (1st session June 12- July 14, skipping week of July 3-7)**
Make sculptural art pieces to place around Akron's Neighborhoods to highlight each area for its likenesses and differences. Use large tools, design, and express your artistic ability with sculpture.
- Graphic Design (1st session June 12-July 14, skipping week of July 3-7)**
Learn design skills to design banners for Copley Road in West Akron. The banners will represent the history of this area. Students will get the opportunity to build their design skills and final designs will be completed on computers.
- Printmaking (1st session June 12-July 14, skipping week of July 3-7)**
Create linocut prints to brighten up areas of Akron. These will be creative collages that will represent the area with some abstract elements and some realistic. The prints will be cut out of linoleum, inked, printed, and scanned into a computer.
- Steel Drums (2nd session July 17-August 11)**
Musically interested apprentices will learn to play the steel drums. They will play at each of the Akron parks concerts on their last week and at many different venues in Akron and beyond. No experience is needed to apply for this component.
- Kenmore Mural (2nd session July 17-August 11)**
Paint a large mural to be placed on the side of the Panyard in Kenmore. This mural will represent the spirit of the steel drum and Trinidad. It will also represent the area of Kenmore and contain bright colors and a musical flow.
- Functional Mosaic Art (2nd session July 17-August 11)**
Create mosaic tables, chairs, and accessories to be placed in an empty lot by Barber school to give the families of the area a place to play and sit with their preschool children. Use mixed mediums to collage on the tables, chairs, and stepping stones.

Interviews will be Sunday, May 7. 1st session interviews (Neighborhood posts, Graphic Design, & Printmaking) will be from 11-2pm and 2nd session interviews (Steel Drums, Kenmore Mural, & Functional Mosaic Art) will be from 3-6pm. Please understand you may have a wait time, as bookings for interviews are based on a first come first serve basis that day. Last interviews for each session will be scheduled at 2 & 6pm. You may interview for multiple sessions let us know when you come in if this is your intention.
